The New DVSA Rules Explained

The DVSA has introduced several important changes to the driving test booking system.

Learners Must Book Their Own Test

Driving instructors can no longer book practical driving tests on behalf of pupils.

All learners must use the official GOV.UK website to:

- Book a driving test
- Change a driving test
- Cancel a driving test

Your instructor can advise and guide you, but the booking must be completed by you.

Limited Changes to Test Appointments

The DVSA has introduced restrictions on the number of times a test can be changed.

This means it's more important than ever to choose the right test date and ensure you're genuinely ready before booking.

Take The Test When You're Ready

Many learners used to book the earliest available test and hope to be ready in time.

The DVSA now encourages learners to book only when they are close to test standard and prepared to take the test.

When Should You Take Your Driving Test?

A good rule of thumb is:

You should be able to:

- ✓ Drive independently without constant instruction
- ✓ Complete manoeuvres confidently
- ✓ Handle roundabouts safely
- ✓ Drive on dual carriageways where appropriate
- ✓ Deal with busy traffic conditions
- ✓ Complete mock tests at test standard

If you're still relying heavily on your instructor's prompts, it's usually too early to take the test.

Common Booking Mistakes

Booking Too Early

Many learners book a test before they have developed the necessary skills.

This creates unnecessary pressure and often leads to test changes or cancellations.

Choosing the Wrong Test Centre

Not all test centres have the same road layouts or traffic conditions.

Speak to your instructor about which test centre is most suitable for your training area.

Ignoring Instructor Advice

Your instructor sees your driving.

If they advise additional preparation, it is usually because they want to maximise your chances of success.

How to Know if You're Test Ready

Ask yourself:

Can I drive for 40 minutes without assistance?

Am I making safe decisions consistently?

Can I deal with unexpected situations calmly?

Do I understand the Show Me, Tell Me questions?

Am I passing mock tests regularly?

If the answer to all of these questions is yes, you're likely approaching test standard.
